INVITATION TO ADMISSION INTERVIEW

The International Committee of the Red Cross and Diakonia Lebanon Resource Desk for International Humanitarian Law (IHL) in cooperation with the Geneva Academy of IHL and Human Rights invites outstanding Arab students and professionals to apply for an admission interview to study at the Beirut Advanced (BEYA) School of IHL 2020 in the period from 31 August-21 September 2020 in Lebanon.

The BEYA School 2020 serves to empower the next generation of international lawyers in the Middle East and North Africa region with an advanced knowledge of international law applicable in armed conflict and to promote the culture of peace through innovative and high-quality teaching. The highly engaging teaching methodology encourages participants to master critical thinking and a unique set of professional skills necessary to apply the law with credibility and confidence.

Successful applicants for the admission interview to the BEYA School of IHL 2020 must satisfy the following selection criteria:

- ✓ Nationality of and residence in an Arabic speaking country
- ✓ Fluency in English
- ✓ Basic knowledge of IHL
- ✓ Availability to attend the School in Beirut during the three weeks (31 August-21 September 2020).

Interested candidates should submit CV, motivation letter and a proof of prior IHL knowledge (e.g. relevant training certificate, publication, university course record) at olotfy@icrc.org.

Deadline for applications: **7 July 2020**.

Admission online interviews will take place on **7-15 July 2020**.

Selected candidates will be notified on **17 July 2020**.
